## **Htc Desire - secure your phone**

Smartphone security is essential. Each owner keeps there confidential data that should be protected. It is not rather possible to secure entirely our phone but at least we'll make sure that direct access has been blocked. This can be easily achieved by turning on the "lock screen" function.

HTC Desire with Android 2.1 has only one possibility of locking the screen - through a pattern. One could draw with a finger across the screen leaving visible "password". That's why many users have complained about this. Such security is not enough except you clean the screen every time, which in turn is not comfortable at all.

Upgrading to version 2.2 of the system has brought two new features - a password and pin. It became more professional now. But forgot about one thing - about forgetting passwords and pins. We protect a phone from unauthorized access, but who protects us from the unreliable memory?

There should be an alternative to unlock the phone. At this point, it appears that the "lock screen" function was underestimated as this type of security has the ability to unlock the phone via authorization to a Google account. I do not know why this feature was omitted. The only thing that was implemented is "slowing down" for 30 seconds after five incorrect password attempts.
